

Check out the new and improved Graphed Scores Report!

Dear AEPSi User,

The next time you run the Graphed Scores report, you may notice some additional options. Not only can you look at the percentage of mastered and emerging skills for each area (the sums of all 1's and 2's), you can also choose other reporting options including:

- % Mastered (2)
- % Emerging (1)
- % Scoring Note A
- % Scoring Note B
- % Scoring Note M
- % Scoring Note Q
- % Scoring Note R



The following table provides more details about these reporting options:

Graphed Scores Reporting Option	Description
% Mastered and Emerging (2 and 1)	This report is the same as the previous existing graphed scores report where the report shows the sum of 1's and 2's as a percentage.
% Mastered (2)	This report shows the percentage of items that were mastered by a child for each area (sum of all items that are scored 2).
% Emerging (1)	This report shows the percentage of items emerging by a child for each area (sum of all items that are scored 1).

% Scoring Note A	This report shows the percentage of items that had an accompanying scoring note of A for each area.
	For example if there are 22 items in an area and 10 have an associated "A" the report would generate that %.
% Scoring Note B	This report shows the percentage of items that had an accompanying scoring note of B for each area.
% Scoring Note M	This report shows the percentage of items that had an accompanying scoring note of M for each area.
% Scoring Note Q	This report shows the percentage of items that had an accompanying scoring note of Q for each area.
% Scoring Note R	This report shows the percentage of items that had an accompanying scoring note of R for each area.

Now you can compare a child's progress over time based on the skills that are emerging, skills that have been mastered, as well as scoring notes!
